PURPOSE: To fund and partner in the purchase of safe sleep supplies for perinatal patients in need.

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The Adventist Health Clearlake Baby Bundles Safe Sleep Program successfully expended all funds awarded under RFA #2025-0012 during the grant period while continuing to provide safe sleep supplies and education to perinatal patients in need. With the support of the Redbud Health Care District, grant funds were used to purchase essential Baby Bundle supplies and deliver safe sleep education, ensuring that resources are available for ongoing distribution beyond the reporting period.

Program Overview

The Adventist Health Clearlake Baby Bundles Safe Sleep Program is designed to promote infant safety by combining evidence-based safe sleep education with access to essential newborn supplies. Each Baby Bundle includes:

- A bassinet or Pack 'n Play
- Swaddles
- A diaper bag
- A thermometer

Participants also complete a safe sleep education class focused on reducing sleep-related infant risks and supporting healthy newborn care practices.

Program Outcomes

During the grant reporting period, the program met all intended objectives of the awarded funds.

- 30 perinatal patients were served
- 30 Baby Bundles were issued
- 30 safe sleep education classes were conducted

Education and supplies were provided concurrently to ensure families received both the knowledge and tools needed to create safe sleep environments for their newborns.

Patient Impact Stories

After attending the Safe Sleep class and receiving her baby bundle, one patient shared that she had originally planned to let her newborn sleep in a swing. The class helped her understand the risks and gave her the confidence to set up a safer sleep environment. She left knowing her baby should always sleep alone on their back, in a crib, and felt empowered to protect her child every night.

Another patient explained that the Safe Sleep class helped correct several common myths her family believed about infant sleep. After learning the Safe Sleep dos and don'ts, she made immediate changes at home by removing loose blankets and placing her baby in a bassinet. The class gave her peace of mind and the knowledge she needed to keep her baby safe while sleeping.

Financials

All grant funds awarded under RFA #2025-0012 have been fully expended in accordance with the approved budget. While all awarded funds have been expended, remaining supplies purchased with these funds will continue to be distributed to eligible perinatal patients until inventory is depleted. Quantities of supplies purchased and distributed during the reporting period are detailed in the accompanying expense report:
