6. Background and Basic Information Regarding Organization

The Middletown Sports Booster Club is a non-profit organization that is committed to supporting the sports teams and athletes of Middletown Unified School District. Although our organization has been supporting local athletics for more than 40 years, our work has become even more important as in recent years the school districts have made the difficult decisions to cut the budgets provided to these teams. Given the decreased amounts provided by the district and increased costs of everything, the need for funding that can be provided by the MSBC has been especially important.

7. Justification

The purpose of the request is looking to have Redbud Health Care District return as the presenting sponsor for our upcoming golf tournament and gala in May 2026. With the funds that RHCD provided as our event sponsor in 2025, we were better able to support the teams and athletes of Middletown. As presenting sponsor of our upcoming tournament, RHCD will continue to support our efforts to provide the equipment needed to keep our athletes safe. Projects that MSBC funded in the past year include providing new pads for the Middletown High School to increase the safety of athletes using the gym, new catchers gear for the Middletown High School softball team, and we are currently exploring options of revitalizing the baseball and softball fields to decrease the safety risks that are currently impacting the baseball and softball programs. If approved, the requested funds will help MSBC continue in our efforts to keep our athletes safe.

8. Intended Use of Funds in Detail

The funds requested will likely support multiple projects across the 2026-2027 athletics seasons. As well as the projects mentioned above, we are currently discussing other projects with Middletown coaches such as ensuring that all wrestling athletes have singlets that fit and headgear to keep athletes safe as well.

9. How intended Use of Funds will Further Delivery of Health Care Services Within Redbud Health Care District

A large amount of the money that is donated by the Middletown Sports Booster Club is used to purchase safety equipment such as padding and other refreshed gear needed to ensure the safety of our athletes. In addition to these types of purchases, providing increased funding to sports teams increases access to athletic outlets that can help improve the health and well-being of Middletown athletes. Participating in sports at an early age has lifelong benefits as these students learn at an early age the importance of being physically active.
