*Redbud Health Care District* awarded Healthy Start \$95,000 to provide Healthy Start services for the following schools in the "South Shore" Konocti and Middletown School Districts area.

### **Program Goals:**

Together, as a team, Healthy Start Youth and Family Services will provide children and families with the resources and support they need to thrive in and create a system that is equitable and inclusive, regardless of race, gender, ethnicity, socioeconomic status, or zipcode. We will work collaboratively with educators, families and community partners promoting resilience to ensure that all children have access to a high-quality education and are prepared for success in college, career and life.

Our partnership with Redbud Health Care District has enabled us to sustain our program of comprehensive health care delivery systems, both prevention, early intervention as well as treatment for students and their families throughout the Konocti Unified and Middletown Unified School Districts. The continued funding from the RHCD allowed us to once again operate as a full service community school model .

### Activities Quarters 1-4 of the 2022-23

The 2022-23 school year was busy from start to finish. Staff received professional development in the areas of case management, strength based protective factors, resource and closed referral process, data collection, motivational interviewing, ACES overcomers, tobacco and cannabis prevention, human trafficking, healthy boundaries and self care and many more.

Staff also participated in various community events such as Back to School nights, Scotts Valley Big Time, Kicks for Kids, Heroes for Health and Safety, Recovery Happeon the various campuses, Red Ribbon Week, Trunk or Treat, Innovation Summit, Dia de Muertos Event, Totes for Teens, Toys for Tots, Clearlake Rotary Christmas, National Children's Oral Health Month, Child Abuse Awareness Month, Foster Youth Awareness Month, Blue Zones Kick Off, Kinder Round Up, and the Children's Festival,

Many linkages to community resources for families in the area of financial support either housing or utility assistance. Four Healthy Start Collaborative and Children's Council meetings shined light on new community resources available to families.

☞ Dental Screenings were scheduled and performed in both districts including respective Early Connections Preschool programs. **2324** total students were screened. (see attached graph). Dental case management at both the main clinic and the wellness clinic at Lower Lake High School saw a multitude of students for a variety of dental treatments. Youth referred out for endodontics or other dental specialties were either transported to Dr. Kurts in Willits, Wisdom 4 dental in Santa Rosa, Wow smiles in Ukiah or Happy Smiles in Fairfield. A few of the younger youth were referred out to PDI in Santa Rosa as well. All preschools, TKs and Kinders were visited by the tooth fairies in February and given an oral health kit and a book to honor National Children's Oral Health month.

***Additional services provided by the various grants operated by Healthy Start:***

**CHILDREN'S ORAL HEALTH PROJECT (First 5 Lake County) and (Lake County Health Services)**

**NURTURING PARENTING PROGRAM (First 5 Lake County)**

- *Provided a 7 week parenting education program for 11 families and their children 0-18 years old at Burns Valley Elementary School. Of the 11 parents, 8 completed all 7 weeks of programming.*
- *Program focused on changing parents' attitudes, giving them skills to use in the home to set appropriate rules, show and discuss feelings.*
- *Grant funding ended June 30, 23*

**MCKINNEY VENTO HOMELESS STUDENTS EDUCATION ACT (Calif. Dept. of Ed)**

- *Assist to identify children that are homeless or in transitional housing.*
- *Provide support services to homeless children and families, so children can attend school, ready to learn.*
- *Assist unaccompanied youth with shelter and community service referrals*
- *Link homeless students to HEALTH CARE and basic needs*

*According to a CalPads certification there were 451 students identified as homeless in Lake County in the 22-23 school year. 169 students were identified as homeless in KUSD and 74 students in Middletown. Healthy Start staff provided service to 139 of these students.*

**HHAP- Homeless Housing and Assistance Prevention Program (Lake County Continuum of Care - in collaboration with Elijah House and Hope Rising**

This grant assisted families of youth couch surfers to be able to stay in a semi permanent situation. This grant paid the host family \$400 monthly to offset the cost of the unaccompanied youth staying there.

**FOSTER YOUTH SERVICES (Calif. Dept. of Education) and Lake County Department of Social Services**

- *Served foster youth in Konociti and Middletown USD schools, K-12, with special outreach and support for students at Lower Lake and Middletown High Schools. Foster youth were served countywide and had regular monthly contacts with staff. Outings through summer leadership programs to places such as UTI, Lytle's Beauty College, Lineman school in Butte County, the movie theater or skating allow foster youth children to network with other children in placement.*
- *Implementation of AB490, with CWS, to ensure that children will stay in their school of origin, even when they are removed from their home.*
- *Assist LCOE and school districts in creating new LCAP goals for foster youth and advising District Superintendent's regarding their obligation to support foster kids.*
- *Summer Leadership program*
- *Educational reviews*

**DIFFERENTIAL RESPONSE PROGRAM – FAMILY PRO (LC Department of Social Services)**

**88 unduplicated** referrals were received from Child Welfare in the 22.23 school year. **59** of those referrals have been for families in the Redbud Health Care District. **30** dumpsters were provided to 18 families. Several families needed multiple bins to cure red tag sanctions.

**DIFFERENTIAL RESPONSE PROGRAM – Probation FAMILY PRO (LC Department of Juvenile Probation) Youth at high risk for formal juvenile probation or detention**

7 referrals from Juvenile Probation were received, 0 referrals have been for families in the Redbud Health Care District.

**Prop 64- Family WRAP (BSCC Board of State and Community Corrections-)  
County of Lake**

Youth on formal juvenile probation with high risk of detention, or stepping down from detention

15 referrals from Juvenile Probation so far this year, 8 have been for families in the Redbud Health Care District.

**SMAA/RMTS (Medi-Cal Administrative Activities Random Moment Time Survey)**

**CBCAP- Community Based Child Abuse Prevention-** Is funding from Children's plate through the Department of Social Services. These monies support the work that is done with the community around child abuse prevention and awareness. This amount fluctuates but tends to vary by a few hundred dollars each year.

**TUPE TIER I, Cohort R/TUPE TA- CDE Prop 56/Prop 99**

TUPE funds provide technical assistance and support to the county school districts around the lake to promote tobacco free campuses. There were 5 TUPE events in KUSD schools.
